#### 1. Introduction

Safaricom PLC is a leading telecommunications company in Kenya offering a comprehensive range of integrated telecommunication services, including mobile and fixed Voice, SMS, Data, Internet, and Mobile money (M-PESA) to over 30 million subscribers. Safaricom currently holds a market share of 69% and commands the widest mobile network coverage enabling it to maintain its position as the region's mobile market leader. To support the wide customer base, Safaricom imports approx. 95% of its network infrastructure and distributes its products to its retail outlets located across the country.

This Expression of Interest (EOI) is intended to lead the identification of experienced suppliers that can deliver a modern logistics monitoring solution that offers real-time tracking and visibility to both imports and local distribution. The solution should leverage technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI) and analytics, reduce operational costs as well as support sustainability goals.

## 2. Scope

The general scope for provision of logistics monitoring solution shall include but shall not be limited to:

- 1. Real-time tracking and communication of consignments on sea, air, rail and road transport.
- 2. Route planning to optimize on load, time and cost
- 3. Automated advance notifications for incoming shipments
- 4. Real-time localization (geographical position) and tracking of shipments from origin port to destination
- 5. Smart alerts on exceptions, delays, early arrivals, route change during transportation
- 6. Support data management and analysis have centralized data storage, customized reports and dashboards for all milestone during shipping/transportation
- 7. Support billing, payments and resource panning provide view for order processing for clients, allow resource allocation based on availability, geography performance and shipping cost
- 8. Address and partner management allow default and manual input of shipping address, partner work allocation based on geographical location and performance
- 9. Performance analysis provide performance of 3PL, shipping lines, airlines and ports.
- 10. Multiple access channels including web and mobile app.
- 11. Support integration with third party APIs- with shipping lines/airlines, freight forwarders system, Order management systems, government agencies e.g Kenya Ports Authority, Kenya Revenue Authority, ICMS, KEBS
- 12. Management of documents generated along the shipping process (shipping manifest, COC, IDF, commercial invoice, Airway bill, Bill of lading, shipping line release order, delivery notes etc.)
- 13. Real time tracking of carbon emission during shipping/transportation
- 14. Achieve 99.9999% availability
- 15. Should be cloud native solution
- 16. Compliance to minimum baseline security (MBS), AD integration and MFA capabilities

- c) EOI respondents who meet the minimum requirements may be called for a detailed presentation for further evaluation of their technical capability, product quality, Quality Analysis procedure, etc. as part of the EOI evaluation.
- d) Only those EOI respondents that meet the minimum requirements indicated in the EOI requirements section will be shortlisted following successful evaluation of their offering/solution proposal.
