1. Introduction

SAFARICOM PLC is the leading integrated communication services provider in Kenya and has a steadily growing subscriber base. Safaricom is continuously expanding and upgrading its systems and processes to meet the changing needs of her customers. To meet this objective Safaricom continuously seeks to collaborate with competent suppliers and service providers for supply of various goods and provision of various services.

This Expression of Interest (EOI) is intended to lead to the identification of experienced suppliers/ (or an authorized dealer or partner) that can deliver modern, all-flash, Backup, Archival, Hyper Converged and NAS storage solutions that address the current and future needs of Safaricom OneCloud. The solutions should enhance Safaricom's competitiveness, leverage technologies such as AI and Automation, reduce operational costs, provide high performance and adaptability, as well as support sustainability goals.

2. Scope

The general scope for provision of storage infrastructure shall include but shall not be limited to:

- a) All-flash, Backup, Archival, Hyper Converged and NAS storage solutions.
- b) Usable and Effective capacity, guaranteed in writing, based on deduplication and compression only (excluding snapshots, clones, or thin provisioning).
- c) Capacity must be upgradable and expandable without downtime or data migration.
- d) Provide tools for efficient and non-disruptive data migration.
- e) Include all current and future features as per the vendor's roadmap without additional costs.
- f) Provide a minimum of 5 years support with fixed maintenance prices, lifetime warranty on all media, non-return options for NVMe drives and controllers, and no EOL/EOSL dates with flat support prices.
- g) Based on storage function, it must deliver high performance throughput.
- h) The observability tool must be AI driven, provide proactive alerting whilst providing detailed metrics, including IOPS, bandwidth, and latency. The storage should also be API driven, able to connect to other observability tools.
- i) Support dynamic scaling and provisioning to adapt to changing needs.
- j) Ensure rapid deployment capabilities with minimal downtime.
- k) Achieve 99.9999% availability, including all software and hardware upgrades.
- l) Maintain full performance under load during controller and disk failures.
- m) Ensure data integrity and availability during simultaneous dual Flash Drive failures.
- n) Design to minimize energy consumption and reduce the data center footprint.
- o) Ensure integration with existing technology ecosystems and future projects.
- p) Support for block protocols NVMe-oF, NVMe-FC, FC, and iSCSI, as well as file protocols NFS and SMB/CIFS.
- q) Support for native, space-efficient snapshots and clones without additional hardware or software.
- r) Built-in asynchronous and near-synchronous remote replication without additional hardware or software.

- s) True Active/Active cluster (Metro Cluster) for business continuity, supporting read and write operations at both sites.
- t) Encryption at rest enabled by default without performance impact or additional hardware.
- u) Support for mixing different sizes of NVMe Flash Drives and SCM drives within the same chassis.
- v) Align with Safaricom's sustainability goals.
- w) Offer ongoing support and maintenance services, including software updates, hardware repairs, and proactive monitoring to prevent issues before they impact operations.
- x) Provide comprehensive training to Safaricom staff on the management and operation of the proposed storage solutions. This includes both initial training during the implementation phase and ongoing training as needed to keep staff up to date with the latest features and best practices.

Bidders are expected to share detailed responses showcasing the firm's capacity and experience in offering Contract management system with the capabilities detailed in the EOI document.

- a) Once Safaricom PLC receives responses to this EOI on the closure date indicated, the evaluator shall evaluate all the responses to the EOI including all supporting documents & documentary evidence. Please NOTE that failure to submit requisite supporting documents or documentary evidence, may lead to rejection of the EOI response.
- b) The Evaluation Committee may seek additional documents as it deems necessary, at its discretion as part of the evaluation exercise that will be undertaken.
- c) EOI respondents who meet the minimum requirements may be called for a detailed presentation for further evaluation of their technical capability, product quality, Quality Analysis procedure, etc. as part of the EOI evaluation.
- d) Only those EOI respondents that meet the minimum requirements indicated in the EOI requirements section will be shortlisted following successful evaluation of their offering/solution proposal.
