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1.0 Introduction

This Expression of Interest (EOI) is intended to lead to the identification of experienced suppliers/ (or an authorized dealer or partner) that can deliver modern compute servers with the below functionalities.

- High-Performance: Advanced & reliable servers to power on critical applications including AL/ML workloads.
- Cost-Effective servers: Competitive pricing and efficient resource utilization to maximize our return on investment.
- Security and Compliance: Robust security measures and adherence to industry standards to safeguard our sensitive data.
- **Flexible Deployment Options**: Options for on-premises, cloud-based, or hybrid deployment models to meet our specific requirements.
- Excellent customer support: Timely and efficient technical assistance.

The servers should enhance Safaricom's competitiveness, leveraging technologies such as AI and Automation, reduce operational costs, provide high performance and adaptability, as well as support our sustainability goals.

2.0 Scope

The general scope for provision of computing infrastructure shall include but shall not be limited to:

1. Performance and Scalability:

- a) *Processor*: High-performance CPUs with multiple cores and threads for efficient multitasking.
- b) *Memory*: Ample RAM to handle demanding workloads and large datasets.
- c) Storage: High-speed SSDs for OS disk (2 xDisks with raid for redundancy) & HBA cards for SAN connectivity for storage access.
- d) Network Connectivity: Robust network interfaces with high bandwidth and low latency. Dual 10G network interface cards

2. Reliability and Uptime:

- a) Redundancy: Redundant power supplies, cooling systems, and network connections, HBA cards to ensure high availability.
- b) Fault Tolerance: Built-in fault tolerance mechanisms to minimize downtime.
- c) Remote Management: Remote monitoring and management tools for proactive maintenance. Out of band management.

3. Security:

- a) Hardware Security: Secure boot, TPM modules, and other hardware-based security features.
- b) Software Security: Regular security updates and patches.

4. Energy Efficiency:

- a) Power-Efficient Processors: Energy-efficient CPUs and power management features.
- b) Efficient Cooling Systems: Optimized cooling solutions to reduce energy consumption.

5. Manageability:
