1. Introduction and Background

Safaricom is a leading integrated communication services provider in Kenya and has a steadily growing subscriber base of subscribers and enterprise clients. The company is continuously expanding the network and upgrading existing capacities to meet the changing needs of its customers. To meet this objective Safaricom continuously seeks to partner with competent suppliers and service providers for supply of various goods and services.

In line with its commitment to provide high availability of services to both internal and external customers, the company is in the process of engaging in partnerships with organizations to implement a fraud management solution that enables detection and blocking of SMS fraud in near real time.

Safaricom PLC is therefore seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified and reputable vendors of an SMS fraud management solution

2. Aims and Objectives

The principle objective of this EOI (Expression of Interest) is for Safaricom to receive information from experienced providers on an SMS fraud management solution. The solution can either be hosted on hardware provided by the vendor at Safaricom premises or virtual environment at Safaricom data center.

The solution should be able to detect and block the following types of frauds among others:

- Illegal use of SMS channels to terminate international traffic through valid on-net or off-net mobile originating SMS, application originating and national inbound routes. This result to messages not being billed at the correct rate.
- SMS Spamming or flooding; This includes unsolicited messages which could serve advertising purposes.
- SMS malware which generate messages which could adversely affect our network and or subscribers.
- International Signalling Fraud where the Global title of the operator or Global title of aggregators is sending fraudulent SMS traffic over SS7 signalling to avoid being billed at the correct international rate.
- National signalling fraud where the national global Title of an operator or global title of national service providers is sending Fraudulent SMS messages over local interconnect to avoid being billed at the correct rate.

3. The EOI Scope

This EOI is intended to identify reputable and qualified suppliers who will be able to deliver on the scope (but is not limited to) below:

Specifically, the solution should be able to;

- 1. Integrate with Safaricom's existing systems, network elements and firewalls.
- 2. Detect the above frauds in near real time
- 3. Block or deter above frauds in near real time
- 4. Provide detailed reports showing traffic volumes by brand, fraud patterns and be able to forecast future fraud trends.

The full details of the scope of the SMS Fraud Management Solution will be provided in an RFP (Request for Proposal) that will be sent out to bidders shortlisted through this EOI process.
